

## Privacy Notice

Unless specified otherwise, all Data (i.e. any information that directly, indirectly, or in connection with other information — including a personal identification number — allows for the identification or identifiability of a natural person) requested by SixthSense s.r.l. (hereinafter the “**Owner**”) is mandatory and failure to provide this Data may make it impossible to the participant (hereinafter “**Participant**”) to participate to the Sixth Sense Call4Design (hereinafter, the “**Award**”).

User who is uncertain about which Personal Data is mandatory are welcome to contact the Owner.

### Methods of processing

The Owner takes appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, modification, or unauthorized destruction of the Data.

The Data processing is carried out using computers and/or IT enabled tools, following organizational procedures and modes strictly related to the purposes indicated. In addition to the Owner, in some cases, the Data may be accessible to certain types of persons in charge, involved with the operation of this Website (administration, sales, marketing, legal, system administration) or external parties (such as third-party technical service providers, mail carriers, hosting providers, IT companies, communications agencies) appointed, if necessary, as Data Processors by the Owner.

The updated list of these parties may be requested from the Owner at any time.

### Legal basis of processing

The Owner may process Personal Data relating to the Participant to the Award since at least one of the following applies:

- provision of Data is necessary for the performance of the obligations which the Participant agreed to perform attending the Award and/or obligations thereof;
- processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Owner is subject;
- processing is related to a task that is carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Owner;
- processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Owner or by a third party.

In any case, the Owner will gladly help to clarify the specific legal basis that applies to the processing, and in particular whether the provision of Personal Data is a statutory or contractual requirement.

### Place

The Data is processed at the Owner's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located.

### Retention time

Personal Data shall be processed and stored for as long as required by the purpose they have been collected for.

Therefore:

- Personal Data collected for purposes related to the performance of the obligations under the Award shall be retained until such understanding has been fully performed.
- Personal Data collected for the purposes of the Owner's legitimate interests shall be retained as long as needed to fulfill such purposes. Users may find specific information

regarding the legitimate interests pursued by the Owner within the relevant sections of this document or by contacting the Owner.

Furthermore, the Owner may be obliged to retain Personal Data for a longer period whenever required to do so for the performance of a legal obligation or upon order of an authority. Once the retention period expires, Personal Data shall be deleted. Therefore, the right of access, the right to erasure, the right to rectification and the right to data portability cannot be enforced after expiration of the retention period.

### **The purposes of processing**

The Data concerning the User is collected to allow the Owner to provide its Service, comply with its legal obligations, respond to enforcement requests, protect its rights and interests (or those of its Users or third parties).

For specific information about the Personal Data used for each purpose, the User may refer to the section “Detailed information on the processing of Personal Data”.

### **The rights of User**

User may exercise certain rights regarding their Data processed by the Owner.

In particular, User has the right to do the following:

- **Withdraw their consent at any time.** Users has the right to withdraw consent where they have previously given their consent to the processing of its Personal Data.
- **Object to processing of its Data.** User has the right to object to the processing of its Data if the processing is carried out on a legal basis other than consent.
- **Access its Data.** User have the right to learn if Data is being processed by the Owner, obtain disclosure regarding certain aspects of the processing and obtain a copy of the Data undergoing processing.
- **Verify and seek rectification.** User has the right to verify the accuracy of its Data and ask for it to be updated or corrected.
- **Restrict the processing of its Data.** Users have the right, under certain circumstances, to restrict the processing of their Data. In this case, the Owner will not process its Data for any purpose other than storing it.
- **To Have its Personal Data deleted or otherwise removed.** User has the right, under certain circumstances, to obtain the erasure of its Data from the Owner.
- **Receive their Data and have it transferred to another controller.** User has the right to receive their Data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and, if technically feasible, to have it transmitted to another controller without any hindrance. This provision is applicable provided that the Data is processed by automated means and that the processing is based on the User's consent, on a contract which the User is part of or on pre-contractual obligations thereof.
- **Lodge a complaint.** User has the right to bring a claim before their competent data protection authority.

### **Details about the right to object to processing**

Where Personal Data is processed for a public interest, in the exercise of an official authority vested in the Owner or for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Owner, User may object to such processing by providing a ground related to its particular situation to justify the objection.

User must know that, however, should its Personal Data be processed for direct marketing purposes, it can object to that processing at any time without providing any justification.

### **How to exercise User's rights**

Any requests to exercise User rights can be directed to the Owner through the contact details provided in this document. These requests can be exercised free of charge and will be addressed by the Owner as early as possible and always within one month.



## **Additional information about Data collection and processing**

### **Legal action**

User's Personal Data may be used for legal purposes by the Owner in Court.

User declares to be aware that the Owner may be required to reveal personal data upon request of public authorities.

### **Information not contained in this policy**

More details concerning the collection or processing of Personal Data may be requested from the Owner at any time.

### **Changes to this privacy policy**

Owner reserves the right to make changes to this privacy policy at any time by notifying its Users on its webpage and possibly - as far as technically and legally feasible - sending a notice to User via any contact information available to the Owner.

Should the changes affect processing activities performed on the basis of the User's consent, the Owner shall collect new consent from the User, where required.

### **Legal information**
